# wine tasting

## **Sparkling Chardonnay Pinot Noir | South Australia | Alc/ Vol: 11.5%**

The grapes for this premium wine have been sourced from sustainably managed vineyards within South Australia. The classic varieties of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir are sourced from a diverse range of vineyard sites. Fresh lifted aromas of citrus, red apples and hints of strawberry and musk. The palate is lively and full of flavour with a creamy texture from malolactic fermentation and a crisp, balanced acidity on the finish.

## **Shared Pinot Grigio | Adelaide Hills | Alc/Vol: 12.5% | 2021**

Pale straw in colour with green highlights. Fresh pear juice with white flowers and a hint of feijoa and cinnamon stick. Initially the palate opens with the flavours of Nashi, cut pear and jasmine then these are followed by baked apple and cinnamon throughout the mid-palate. These generous fruit flavours are complemented by a rich mouth-feel and a creamy lingering finish.

## **Weave Chardonnay | South Australia | Alc/Vol 13.0% | 2022**

Good late winter and early spring rainfall replenished the soils. A mild, wet spring kept moisture levels up to the growing vines. Summer and autumn were mild and dry which was ideal for ripening the grapes and allowed us to harvest at the perfect ripeness.

Pale straw with green hues. Rich tropical fruit such as paw paw and mango, blossom notes combine with sweet spice. The wine has a savoury edge with flinty notes from the wild ferment. The flavours from the nose are balanced by the creamy mid palate and tight acid finish. A veritable fruit salad of flavours that linger well after consumption.

## **The Debutant Counoise Carignan | Barossa Valley | Alc/Vol 13.5% | 2024**

Every year we trial a number of different varieties to see how they show in the wonderful Barossa climate. These small parcels are usually blended away until we tasted the old and rare French variety Counoise with the historical Spanish variety of Carignan from a single vineyard. We picked these two varieties together as a field blend and co-fermented in an open fermenter. Vibrant, fresh, light style and screaming for friends and food, this wine is an example of what can be done when you push the boundaries.

## **CHEFIN Pinot Noir | South Australia | Alc/ Vol: 11.5% | 2022**

Bright ruby red in colour. This Pinot Noir will surprise with aromas of stalk, sage, black olive, strawberry and hints of hazelnut. The palate has loads of red fruit, showing pomegranate and cranberry with a vibrant juiciness that leads to some delicious edgy tannins.

## **Auswan Creek Diplomat 30 Merlot | Barossa Valley | Alc/Vol 13.5% | 2021**

Medium bodied, dry red Deep red in colour with lifted aromas of cherry and mulberry with a hint of mocha; flavours of sweet plum and spice with subtle savoury French oak. A medium to full bodied wine with velvety tannins, long and soft with a silky smooth finish. Well matched with tomato based Italian dishes and grilled meats such as veal, pork or lamb.

## **Auswan Creek 1908 Barossa Valley Shiraz | Barossa Valley | Alc/Vol: 14.5% | 2020**

"Fabulous rich fruit intensity combined with vanilla pod, game and clove notes lead the way to a plush palate that's succulent and smooth. Beautifully rounded and weighted with a lengthy delectable. The wine is all about the lovely fruit character. Perfect with any BBQ and pork ribs. Gently destemmed, not crushed. Whole berry fermentation by open fermenter, pumped over twice per day, using bivalent strains of *S.Cerevisiae* and *S.Bayanus*, carried in between 22-24 degrees Celcius. Fermenting for 9-11 days and then basket pressed. Ageing in oak Matured for 2 years in 50% new oaks and 50% 1-year-old oaks. Using Mixed French and American Hogshead.

## **Inspire Bay Sparkling Pink Moscato | South Australia | Alc/Vol: 8.5% | 2024**

This Split Pick Moscato from South Australia is a gem of a wine displaying a pale rose hue. The blissful bouquet is an amalgam of pink rose, musk and strawberry fragrances, while the fruit-driven, light and juicy palate is full of exotic tropical fruit flavours which balance the sweetness of the wine to provide a crisp and persistent finish. This wine should be served chilled either as an aperitif or clubbed with a light and delicious brunch.
